Fire	Students and staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none">No naked flames in or around the campsite.All fires to be well away from canvass and in an area where water or extinguishers are to hand.All people present made aware of the warning for a fire and where to assemble.Fire Procedure to be followed.All belongings to be left and students to evacuate to safe place in a quick orderly fashion.In very dry areas make sure that fire is aay from dry grass and that area where fire is made that the ground has been saturated with water to prevent spread.	Low	Teaching staff to be made aware of their responsibilities.

If fire occurs while on an activity staff should move to the safest place making sure all group is safe, teaching staff should have a list of group to ensure all students are present, inform campsite staff or if required 999

If fire occurs on camping area all students to be moved to designated fire area, teaching staff should check their groups to ensure all students are present, inform campsite staff or if required 999.

Only return when Camp Warden or designated staff has deemed it safe.

In case of serious incident school should follow instructions until safe and then begin their serious incident procedure.
