Country Roads	Students and Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Walk in single file• Walk into the oncoming traffic• Pay extra attention when walking around corners in the road.• Make students aware of when traffic is coming so that they can stop and allow vehicles to pass.	Low

Low	Walks for groups will have been walked by group leaders before.
Uneven Ground	Students and staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Everybody should be wearing suitable supportive footwear. • Warn group of any upcoming hazards. • No running. 	Low
