# Wk 1: Outdoor Adventure holiday club – Information for parents.



We look forward to welcoming your child to our adventure week and have attached some additional information, which will assist us in keeping them as safe as possible throughout the week.

1. Please try to walk into the main drop off/ pick area if possible –our staff will meet you in the Moravian settlement entrance 8.55. Please do not arrive any earlier.
2. Children will be split into their designated bubble for the week.
3. Registration will be completed
4. Parents/ carers are not permitted to come up to the main activity area.
5. Temperature checks will be taken and participants will need to stand with their bubbles for the week – at least 1m apart.
6. Packed lunches must be brought by the child and all waste will go home with each individual.
7. Water will be available throughout the day.
8. Please look at the weather for the week and dress appropriately. Emergency shelter will be available for extreme situations but our holiday club 99.9% outside. Waterproofs/ wellies etc... sun cream if it's hot.
9. Collection from the square at 4pm

**Rules: No aggressive or intentional physical contact between participants or abusive language. This will result in your place at holiday club being cancelled and no refund will be issued. Any question should be directed to the email system and a director will be with you as soon as possible.**
