Loose Holds	Students and staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff to check holds before activity, secure any loose holds and ensure to pre warn students that holds may spin. 	Low	
Falling from traverse wall	Students and staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Thorough instruction should be given before session begins. Explain about learners keeping three points of contact. Remind students holds may spin. Demonstrate and show the role of the spotter. Only have two people using the traverse wall at any given time. Remind other learners to remain seated and to follow the correct order. 	Low	
Wall	Students and staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make sure all mats are laid flat and that there are no overlapping areas. Make it clear to students not to put there hands over the top of the traverse wall. Make sure students do not use the anchor points as holds. Remind students to watch their heads on the beams. Learners are not to use overhang unless supervised closely. Overhang should have two crash mats underneath. 	Low
